

VACCINE AVAILABILITY

For January Missouri is looking to get all healthcare workers and nursing home staff and residents vaccinated. Those supplies are coming in, but there is not yet enough. In Lafayette County, we will soon have a very limited supply of vaccine to offer front line healthcare workers who have not received it elsewhere.

We are hoping in February that vaccine supplies will be larger and we will be able to start taking appointments for those 65 and older. There will be no list of names. We will announce the availability through every possible news media. We also hope that some pharmacies and medical offices will have it then too.

Later this spring we hope to start offering it to the general public. We will take appointments here, operate a public vaccine site, and some pharmacies and some medical offices will have it too. This too will be announced through every possible channel when available.
